



2014 Accomplishments

- * 40 Schools in Oregon and Washington are participating in our program - approximately 15,000 students
- *Partnerships with The Snowman Foundation and Oregon Music Hall of Fame have brought additional music education opportunities to our students and local schools
- * Music Workshop is now online for all schools
- *Each school is required to provide feedback on each episode prior to advancing to the next episode in the series
- *The Genre Series and Instrument Series launched with success - currently 9 episodes have been launched to participating schools
- *All fundraising matches were successful
- *Our first fundraiser was a huge success. After expenses, we raised over \$17,000
