Music Workshop is an innovative supplemental music program that is offered for free to all elementary and middle schools. Currently we are presenting the program in 40 schools in Oregon and Washington and our hope is to grow that number exponentially next school year. This school year we are presenting the Genre series teaching the students about Jazz, Rock, Classical, R&B and Country and our Instrument Series educating students on the Piano, Guitar, Voice, Percussion, Strings and Unique Instruments. All of our curriculum is presented on line and feedback is required for schools to advance in the programming.
